

THE MUNICIPAL By-LAW OF URBAN WASTE AND PUBLIC CLEANING REGARDING PRUNING.

**ARTICLE 89.-C)** : It is not allowed to deposit pruning or garden waste in public areas.

### **IN ORDER TO GET RID OF SMALL AMOUNT OF GARDEN WASTE:**

**ARTICLE 31.- d)** : The garden waste has to be cut in pieces and put in rubbish bags. The maximum of 2 rubbish bags are allowed ( 35,80 l). The bags have to be deposited inside of the rubbish container.

### **IN ORDER TO GET RID OF BIG AMOUNT OF GARDEN WASTE:**

**ARTICLE 23.- :**

If any natural or legal person had to discard waste in larger quantities, should contact the municipal cleaning services and they will decide whether these waste may be deposited with the regular waste. The municipal cleaning services may require reduction of the amount of waste. The user must pay any extra costs which this rubbish collection may cause. **The user may be authorized to transport the garden waste at his own expenses to the Recycling Centre.**

**ARTICLE 21.- :**

**Should the waste be handed over not complying with the established conditions,** the interested people can be cahrged with the additional costs for withdrawal, notwithstanding possible fines.

**ARTICLE 31.- :**

4.- Frequency and timetable

**The full bags can be deposited in the containers** on public road nbetween 9:00 pm and 11:00 pm. The waste will be withdrawn daily.

**General:** The waste has to be deposited in a suitable form, liquid and possibly liquefying elements are forbidden, adequate, closed, resistant plastic bags have to be used, so that they don't break and there will be no dumping.
